Cycling

Cycling is a fast and cost-effective mode of transport. By cycling, you could save yourself money on the purchase, running and parking costs of owning and running a car.

To get cycling, you may need a few things first from your local cycle shop. We recommend a quality lock, bright clothing, a sturdy helmet and some bike lights to keep you visible at night.

As a resident of Samares Nurseries, you will be eligible to obtain a £10 voucher to use towards the purchase of cycle equipment.

EVie Services

EVie Bikes are available across Jersey, offering a cheap and sustainable form of transport for shorter journeys for a minimum charge of £1.12.

Micro Cars and Round-Trip Cars & Vans are also available through EVie for short term rent for a minimum of £1.25 and £10, respectively. EVie services are easy to use through the EVie App.

Cut Your Bills by Car Sharing

If you do need to use your car, you could share some of your regular journeys with friends or colleagues. Even if you only car share once a week, that's still enough to achieve some serious results!

The cost of driving your own car is often more than the cost of the fuel. By car sharing, you can share these costs with your passenger(s). Research has shown that the average car share user saves more than £1,000 a year! For example, if you share your regular car journey with another driver, each taking it in turns to drive one week to work, you could reduce your fuel bill by a half. The fewer miles driven may also help to reduce wear and tear on your vehicle.

Electric Vehicle Charging Points

Electric cars offer zero tailpipe emissions and low-cost refuelling. The cost of powering an electric car for 10,000 miles is around £1000.

In comparison, the cost of diesel for the same distance would be over £1,350. If the majority of your journeys are short, now is a great time to consider changing to an electric car.
